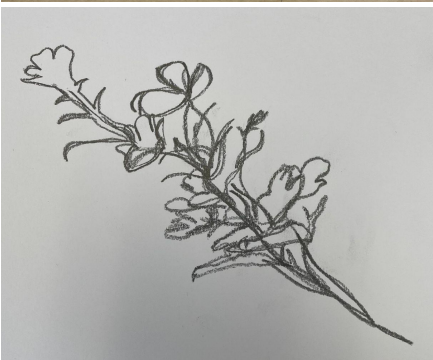

Governor Inslee announced that the state's indoor mask mandate will be lifted beginning March 12, 2022.
